SAGE Publishing on "How to Get Published" at SciX 2016

SAGE Publications and the Society for Applied Spectroscopy will be hosting a "How to Get Published" session at SciX on Tuesday, 20 September, 2:00–3:30 pm. We encourage those new to research or those wanting a refresher on publishing their work in journals to attend. Louisa Strain and Naomi Blumsom from SAGE and Kristin MacDonald, the Managing Editor of Applied Spectroscopy, will be speaking. The session will cover the fundamentals of preparing a manuscript for publication in an academic journal, with direct reference to SAS's own journal Applied Spectroscopy. The session will include: an overview of the publishing landscape, how the publishing landscape is evolving, how to select a relevant publication, preparing your manuscript for submission to a journal, an overview of the peer review process, publication ethics and author rights, and how to promote your article once published.
